Instructions for use

After laying the floor properly, uniformly distribute two or three thin coats of Resinal Wax using a previously moistened clean cloth, waiting 60 minutes between the coats. Any old layer can be removed using the Nettardue wax remover (consult data sheet of the product).

Notes

Always use only damp and well wrung out rags and cloths, avoiding excess of water. Shake before using.

Do not exceed the amount of product applied.
