

# Line Maker

## Medium-duration water-based paint for marking synthetic grass sports fields

Line Maker is a water-based acrylic paint designed for marking boundary lines on natural and synthetic grass sports fields. Suitable for both indoor and outdoor pitches, it offers excellent coverage and a final mat, natural appearance.

Storage	12 months in sealed original packaging at temp > 10 °C
VOC	17 g/litre, cat A/e (WB), limit 130 g/litre (2004/42/EC)
Tool cleaning	Water
Available packaging	Buckets of 15 kg and 7.5 kg

### Application instructions

Stir the product thoroughly using a low-speed drill to avoid incorporating too much air. Line Maker can be used pure or diluted with a maximum of 10% water. The use of dedicated line marking machines ensures uniform application, as well as optimal coverage and line definition. Apply at least two coats of Line Maker at intervals of approximately 6 – 8 hours.

### Notes

Protect freshly painted surfaces from rain. Do not apply on wet or frozen surfaces, or when rain is expected shortly.
